BCLTA TRUSTEE AND SUPPORTER AWARDS

Now is your chance to say a great big THANK YOU to a Trustee, Individual or Group who has really supported your library. The awards will be presented at the BCLA/BCLTA Library Conference in April. Let's celebrate some of the people who make our libraries so special.

There are three BCLTA award categories – each has a **nomination deadline of February 15, 2007**:

Super Trustee Awards

The Super Trustee Award is for the Trustee who always puts in the extra effort; takes on the tough jobs or is just outstanding at everything. More than one Super Trustee Award may be granted in a given year.

Nancy Bennett Award

This award (only one per year) recognizes a trustee who has contributed to library service provincially or regionally within the past two years.

Advocacy Awards

These awards are an opportunity to recognize a volunteer, an individual, or a group who has provided exceptional support for your library. Nominations for this award are open year round; however, for presentation/recognition at the Conference, the nomination deadline is February 15, 2008.

The Canadian Library Trustees' Association is also accepting nominations for its **CLTA Merit Award** for Distinguished Service as a Public Library Trustee. Their nomination deadline is February 28, 2008.
