Dear Directors and Chairs of Small Libraries/Branch Libraries:

Please find attached a news release and application information for the Towns for Tomorrow provincial infra-structure grant program, available for communities under 5,000 population via the Ministry of Community Services.

Municipal and community library projects are specifically mentioned as qualifying in section 2.1 of the Program Guide.

Cost-shared grants of up to \$400,000.00 per project (80% provincial/20% local) will be awarded for 3 years, starting in the Spring of 2007.

Applications must be submitted by an incorporated municipality that has a population of 5,000 persons or less, or the Central Coast Regional District

The application deadline for 2007 is: February 16, 2007.
